STEP 01

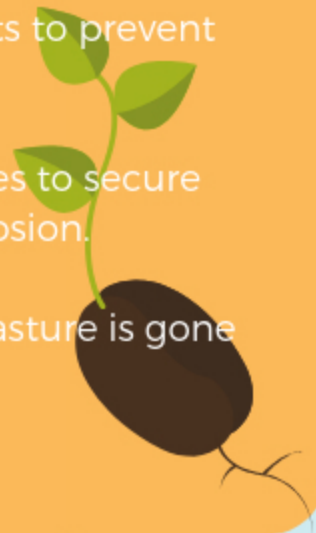
2. Regularly drench your sheep to maintain the health of the animal and the wool.



SOIL MANAGEMENT

STEP 02

- Plant perennial plants to prevent salinity of the soil.
- Plant shrubs and trees to secure soil and minimise erosion.
- Move stock before pasture is gone to promote growth.



STEP 03

Provide stock with CLEAN water sources.



FOOD AND WATER

Check the quality of feed before distribution.



NLIS TAGGING

Using National Livestock Identification Tags ensures that sheep are identifiable and can be tracked throughout their lifetime.
